“These birds migrate at night, using the stars for guidance. Researchers demonstrated this process in the late 1960s by studying captive birds in a planetarium and then under the natural night sky. The birds possess an internal clock that enables them to continually adjust their angle of orientation to a star—even as that star moves through the night sky.”
