Purple Gallinule

In hatchlings, the bill features a “band of pale livid pink; the remainder of the maxilla distal to the latter band is black. . . . The tip of the mandible (lower) is black, the base flesh pink with a narrow black band and one of hydrangea pink.” (A. O. Gross and J. Van Tyne, *Auk* 46 [1929])
