One look at this feather should tell you what bird it fell from. It is probably more difficult to identify the bird if you live in western north America. Can you identify the bird?



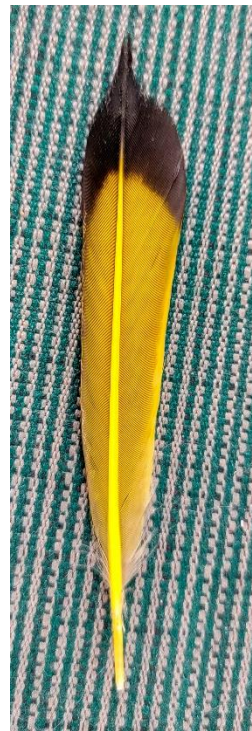
